Please remember to use water wisely.

Leaf Pick-Up Leaf pick-up will be held on **Tuesday, April 13th** for the East side of Pennsylvania Avenue and on **Wednesday, April 14th** for the West side of Pennsylvania Avenue. **These two days only!** Leaves must be placed to allow easy access for pick-up. **No Tarps or coverings.** The Borough will not come across your property to pick them up. The leaves must be placed curbside at least 10 feet away from poles, cars, and other obstructions! **KEEP BRUSH AND GRASS CLIPPINGS SEPARATE FROM LEAVES or they will NOT be picked up!** If you have any Questions please call the Borough Office at 364-1772.

Fire Hydrant Flushing will be held on May 18 & May 19th.

Zoning Permits are required. Please contact the Borough Office to obtain and fill out a zoning permit. The Zoning Officers will then direct you to our Building Code Administrator if necessary.

Ordinance Violations – To file a complaint the filer needs to leave their name, phone number, and be willing to testify in court.

Animal Defecation Ordinance The Borough ordinance requires **dog and cat** owners to pick up after their animals. With continued violations, fines can be as high as \$600.00. Animals are not permitted to run loose in the Borough.

Barking Dog Ordinance It is the owner's responsibility to keep their dog (s) quiet and under control, if there is continuous barking of more than 10 minutes the owner can be cited a fine up to \$300.00.

Rein in Your Cats Cats cannot run loose. They must be kept inside or on your property. Fines for loose cats are up to \$300.00.

Cigarettes Butts are litter, please take them with you.

Brush Pick-Up Brush pick-up will begin on **Tuesday, April 20th** for the East side of Pennsylvania Avenue and on **Wednesday, April 21st** for the West side of Pennsylvania Avenue. Brush must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. each day of pick-up. There will be no second time around for pick-up. **Special notes:** Tree branches do not need to be cut short. If tree trunks are greater than 8 inches in diameter, the property owners must make other arrangements to haul the tree trunk away. **Please stack brush with butt ends toward the road and cut to a size to go through the shredder.** Small branches need to be bundled and tied with a string. **NO WIRE. Shrub trimmings (Thorn bushes, rose bushes, and grape vines) are not brush** and should be composted or placed in your trash. All trees on Borough or State right-of-ways are maintained by the Borough.

Riff-Raff/Bulk Items Riff-Raff/Bulk Items days will be held on **Wednesday, May 5th** for the East side of Pennsylvania Avenue and **Thursday, May 6th** for the West side of Pennsylvania Avenue. All items **must** be curbside by 7:00 a.m. on pick-up day. **NO PAPERS, NO LEAVES, NO BRUSH, NO MOUNTED TIRES, NO LARGE TRUCK TIRES, NO TRACTOR TIRES.** What are Riff-Raff/Bulk Items? **Tires, Appliances, Wood/Old Lumber, Furniture, Mattresses & Box Springs.** Any items the regular garbage collectors will not take. **Appliances with food of any nature inside will not be picked up.**
